BURLINGTON – Exclusive chocolates will be paired with fine wine at a new event at ChocolateFest this year.

The evening of “Chocolate Indulgence” will take place from 8-10 p.m. Saturday, May 24, under the Chocolate Experience tent. The festival grounds are located off of Highway 36 in Burlington.

Entrance to the event, for adults only, is \$5 and includes wine samples and chocolate pairing, a special Chef presentation by Jimmy Wade, owner and chef at Heaven City (and his band), a commemorative wine glass, and a trip through the chocolate experience line filled with specialty desserts, including samples of the Bake-Off entries, warm Midwest Airlines Chocolate Chip cookies, and desserts from Lakeview Farms. Wade will make a Chocolate Covered Candied Morel Mushroom piped with Dark Belgium Chocolate Mousse.

The ticket is available at the Chocolate Experience Tent prior to the start of the event and at the Chocolate Expressions store in Burlington.

The Chocolate Experience tent, where premier chocolate vendors are located and other chocolate events take place throughout the festival, will be closed to general admission patrons during the event.

Rice’s Liquor – just across the street from the festival grounds – is sponsoring this event and will have the featured wines available at their store.

Children are welcome under the adjacent Kids Kanopy during the event, where the movie “Charlie and the Chocolate Factory” will be presented. Complimentary chocolate popcorn and chocolate milk will be provided.
